PAC Coaches Mission Statement

- We do all for the Glory of God. Our lives and our actions are examples that will be followed by those we train. Every training session and every game will be coached to show Christ to our players.
- We will provide a positive, enjoyable and structure learning environment for all of the players.
- We will focus on total player development. We acknowledge that our coaching is critical in assisting the parents of the players to teach their children life lessons.
- Total player development includes:
 - 1) Instruction in the Four Pillars of Soccer; Technical, Tactical, Mental and Physical.
 - 2) Strength and Fitness instructions
 - 3) Nutritional Instruction
 - 4) Instructions in developing mental strength
 - 5) Self-discipline instructions
 - 6) Cooperation and teamwork instructions
- As coaches in Providence Athletic Club we recognize that we set examples for the player. We will set good examples for the kids in the following ways:
 - 1) We will show respect for our kids in how we dress for games and practices.
 - 2) We will show respect for our kids in how we speak to them during games and practices.
 - 3) We will show respect for those in authority over us by how we speak to officials at games.
 - 4) We will set the example by being on times for all practices and games.
 - 5) We will help build our players by giving them positive reinforcement and helping to build a sense of self-worth and pride in their work.
- We recognize that coaching for Providence Athletic Club is a precious gift. We will protect that gift with our words and actions in the community at large.

Coaches and Leaders Protection Safeguards

In order to protect our leaders and coaches against false accusations of wrong doing the following guidelines will be followed:

- leaders will never have private conversations with players off the playing field without parents knowledge.
- leaders do not provide transportation to players, male or female, without a 3rd party in the car unless parents have signed the Parents Consent Ride form
- leaders do not front hug the opposite sex or offer gifts.
- any interaction outside of PAC is always done with the parents full knowledge. (IE phone calls, texting, email, FB)



- No coach or club official shall have a discussion with the parent of a child when the topic is that child without at least one other coach or club official present.

Leadership and Coaches Statement of Faith
